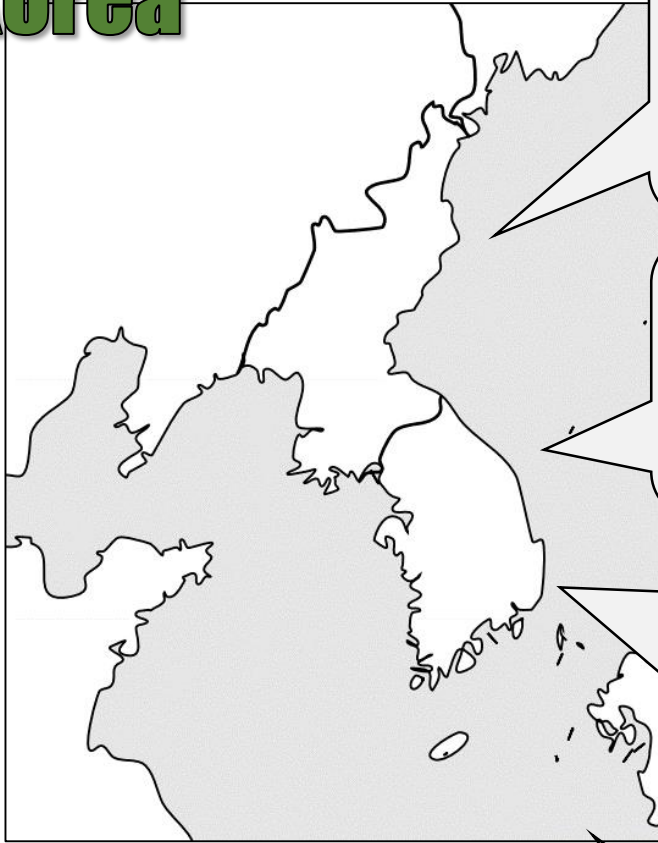

## The Paris Peace Agreement
